Ephesians 2:10

"For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

The Greek poiema — "handiwork" — means a crafted masterpiece. You were designed with intention. The works are already prepared; our call is to see where God is working and say YES!

Psalms 139:16

"All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be."

God's purposes for your life are not improvised — they are written, personal, and secured in Him.

Jeremiah 29:11 · Proverbs 16:9

"For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord..." · "In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps."

God holds the map. Our surrender opens the door to the path He has already paved.

REFLECTION

- > **WHERE** do I sense God stirring something in me — a burden, a skill, a door opening — that I have not yet stepped through?
- > **AM** I walking in step with the Spirit (Galatians 5:25), or am I running ahead or holding back?
- > **WHAT FEARS OR DISTRACTIONS** are keeping me from the works God has already prepared? (2 Timothy 1:7)
- > **DO I BELIEVE I AM TRULY HIS POIEMA** — crafted with purpose — or am I living as though my life is accidental?

<p>01 — SURRENDER</p> <p>Lord, I yield my agenda. Let Your prepared works take priority over my own plans today.</p>	<p>02 — SIGHT</p> <p>Open my eyes to the needs, opportunities, and nudges You have placed around me right now.</p>
<p>03 — COURAGE</p> <p>Give me boldness to step forward even when the full path isn't visible. I trust the Planner.</p>	<p>04 — EQUIPPING</p> <p>Sharpen every gift and skill You have given me so I am ready for all You have prepared. (2 Tim 3:17)</p>
<p>05 — GUIDANCE</p> <p>Lead me by Your Spirit in the small moments — a word, a call, a kindness — that forms Your bigger purpose.</p>	<p>06 — FAITHFULNESS</p> <p>Keep me faithful in the works already in front of me. Let me be trustworthy in little. (Luke 16:10)</p>
